

POLICY TYPE: EXECUTIVE EXPECTATIONS**POLICY TITLE: PROGRAM CHANGE NOTICE**

The Superintendent shall not make extensive changes in existing programs without first informing the Board.

Policy Definition:

1. "Extensive changes" means termination or substantial reduction of existing programs as well as initiating new substantial programs.
2. "Informing the Board" means sufficient notice and information adequate for Board consideration:
 - A. Notice is to be timely enough to allow discussion at a regular Board meeting if the Board chooses to do so.
 - B. Information includes basic program data with "Ends" implications and management rationale.
 - C. "Board consideration" does not mean approval or disapproval, but determination:
 - (1) That Board policy is being implemented by using a reasonable interpretation; and
 - (2) Whether the concrete plans cause the Board to want to change its existing policy language.
