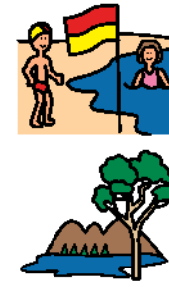


I am Going on Vacation

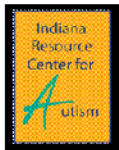
