Playdough

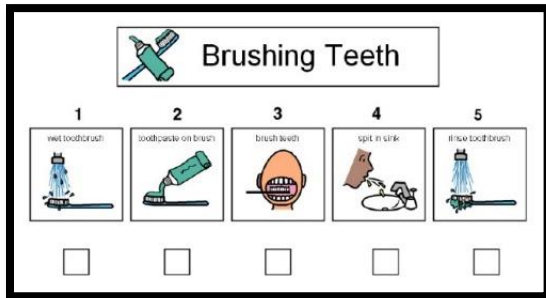


At this station your child will receive a small amount of playdough. This can help with fine motor skills when making a ball or flattening the dough. Your child can use his/her

imagination making pretend food, cars, or snakes. And social skills and communication when talking with others about what he/she made or the color of the playdough.



Visual Schedule



At this station you will have the opportunity to develop visual schedules, first/then cards, and a variety of routines for your child's everyday life. These routines will provide you with the tools to allow change in your day with the visual supports many students need.

Social Narrative



socially appropriate responses or behaviors to help children learn and use appropriate social skills. Many premade social narratives will be available to take home with you.

Touch Books



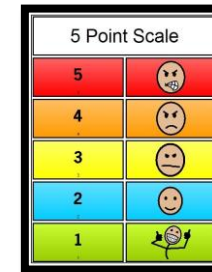
At this station you will be able to build your own touch books with different fabrics for your child to feel for sensory input.

5 Point Scale



At this station you will receive and learn about the 5 point scale. It is a visual resource that reduces abstract ideas into simple numbers. The scale breaks down a

variety of behaviors in concrete parts to help students better understand what you are asking of them.



Cookbook



At this station you and your child will be able to choose from a variety of recipes with picture cues to help your child cook on his/her own. Your child will be able to easily follow the visuals in order to successfully prepare a

meal. You will have a choice of which recipes to include in your child's visual cookbook.
