All participants must have a family physician as the screening report is sent to the physician.

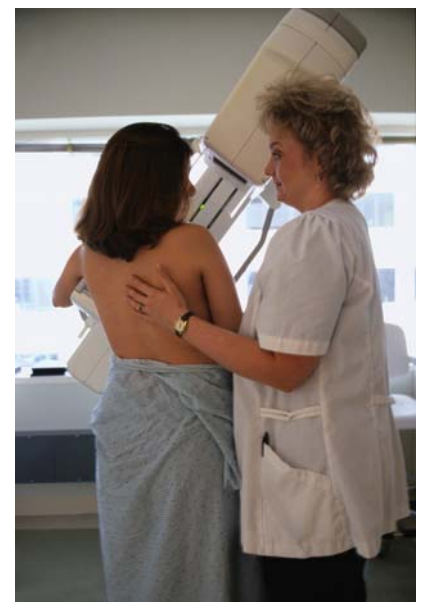
