IN THE NEWS:

- **Cedarville Elementary School** students donated items to bless 5 area families this past holiday season (through the Grabill Food Bank). Given were 2,193 non-perishable items, 250+ wrapped gifts, and over \$1,500 in gift cards.
- **Heritage Elementary School** students are always learning, growing, and exploring by participating in extracurricular activities such as intramurals, art club, choir, and math bowl.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

New Haven High School - Renovations/Additions

The relocation of high school classrooms (predominately 2nd floor and Special Ed 1st floor) to the new two story classroom addition (flex space) has started and should be completed this weekend. In the prior administrative area: the masonry walls for the new classrooms and hallways have been laid and the floors are being prepped. In the auxiliary gym area: the basketball goals were installed, scoreboards installed, wood gym flooring installed and stained, in the locker rooms the floor tile and grout installed, and the install of the all-purpose flooring in the auxiliary gym is scheduled to start in the next week.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

Masonry work continues throughout the project: all of the interior masonry walls in the classroom wing (1st & 2nd floor have been laid) and the exterior masonry walls in the art and music area of Unit A are more than 75% complete. The gym roof joists have been laid. Interior walls in the classroom addition have been painted. The first coat of paint in the kitchen has been applied. The stud wall framing in the office area is complete.

Cedarville Elementary - Conversion to City Utilities

Cedarville Elementary School is now on city water. During the evening of Thursday (January 17th) the well water lines were disconnected and the water lines from City Utilities were connected.
