## CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

### New Haven High School - Renovations/Additions

In the former administrative area: the masonry walls for the new classrooms and hallways have been painted. In the auxiliary gym area: started the install of the all purpose flooring; acoustic wall tile installed; the wood gym floor is stained and sealed; the lockers in the locker rooms have been placed; toilet fixtures, partitions, and ceiling grids have been installed in the locker rooms; in the public restrooms in the corridor the fixtures, partitions and ceiling grid installed; installed the ceiling grid in the athletic offices in the aux gym entrance; and the terrazzo flooring in the corridor has been poured and about half has been ground/polished.

### New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The media center slab was poured. The block wall around the music room is complete from mezzanine to roof deck. The steel joists and deck have been set over the east half of the corridor in Unit A. The roof deck over the gym is complete. The roof over the media center/mezzanine/gym has been installed. The first coat of paint has been applied in the kitchen. Framing of bulkheads on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Unit C (classroom addition) has begun, they are finishing the drywall on the first floor of Unit C, and started the install of the ceiling grids in classrooms in Unit C. Should complete the piping to the unit ventilators for the classrooms in the next week.

I want to give a HUGE shout out to **New Haven High School's** administrators, staff, custodians and students who came together and worked tirelessly moving furniture and equipment into the new classrooms! This was a massive undertaking; and because of their efforts, our custodians did not have to work over the weekend! Teamwork!
