CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

New Haven High School - Renovations/Additions

The new classrooms are being utilized for instruction. The auxiliary gym area is ready for use. Display cases are yet to be completed. The wood flooring in the main gym has been removed. The new roof top units are to be set over spring break. In the 2nd floor classroom renovation areas: the ceramic tile was laid in the student restrooms; terrazzo flooring was poured; painting in classrooms and hallways is in process; work has begun on the installation of the ceiling grids. In the 1st floor classroom renovation areas: the SPED classroom masonry walls have been installed; the ceramic flooring has been laid in the SPED classroom restrooms; and ceramic flooring in the corridor student restrooms.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

The ceiling grids in the main corridors on the 2nd floor of Unit C (classroom addition) are complete. The block filler and first coat have been applied in the gym. The drywall office walls have been installed and priming/painting is in process. Painting started on door frames in Unit C and in the administration office area. Installation has begun on the carpet and base in the 1st floor Unit C classrooms. The casework for the 2nd floor classrooms have been delivered. The face brick for Units A & B and kitchen/cafeteria are complete. The laying of face brick continues, which is almost complete; Started laying brick on the north wall of the classroom addition. The installation of the visual display boards (i.e. whiteboards) in the Unit C 2nd floor classrooms are complete. The terrazzo flooring in the 1st floor classroom addition has been poured and they have started on the 2nd floor. Work continues on the installation of the sprinkler piping in Units A & B.
